The Communist Party of Italy continues its organizational work with great activity and success everywhere. Revolutionary proletarian forces are enthusiastically joining our ranks, those of the Communist International, thereby demonstrating their understanding of the enormous importance of the recent Congress of Livorno. At that congress, the socialist party split, decisively separating revolutionary communists from the social democrats, the open reformists, and the semi-reformists allied with them.

While the old party, where all the indecisive and ambiguous elements have remained, is fatally drifting to the right and openly renouncing the struggle against the bourgeois regime, it is of utmost importance for the Italian proletariat, which has felt the need for a party capable of leading revolutionary action, to organize itself rapidly and strengthen itself as a unique class party: the Communist Party, united with all the communists of the world within the Moscow International. Not a minute can be lost in this preparatory work, for the decisive battles that lie ahead may call us to the field of action at any moment, with all our forces.

It is therefore urgent to complete the network of local Party organizations throughout the country as soon as possible. It is crucial that all proletarians understand why the Communist Party has emerged, how it is organized, and what its intentions are. Therefore, all communists must undertake extensive propaganda work among the masses.

One of the urgent needs of our action is the systematic organization of our press, especially the daily press. Currently, our two newspapers, L'Ordine Nuovo in Turin and Il Lavoratore in Trieste, valiantly represent our cause. However, due to the position of these two cities, it is necessary for a newspaper to become the central organ of the Communist Party: Il Comunista, currently a fortnightly publication of the Party Executive Committee, must be transformed into a daily.

We call upon all comrades for a swift and victorious campaign to achieve these two objectives: to solidly establish the Communist Party among the Italian proletarian masses and to obtain the necessary resources to establish a central communist daily that will spread throughout Italy, being the banner of the proletariat in its struggle for communism and revolutionary liberation.

With these objectives in mind, the Central Committee of the Communist Party is organizing a great

In every town and city, large and small, where there is a communist section or nucleus, a public meeting must be organized.
