The minute details of communist society are so vast (complex) that they can become incalculable, however this does not replace for us the exploration of the future with the exploration of the past and present.

To prove the existence of the movement towards communism, it is necessary to demonstrate what communism is, what attributes it has.

One must go further than trying to prove communism as possible through a theorization of precise arrangement of forms of government and organisation, by proving not only its possibility to the audience of the 'population', to an office full of bureaucrats, or to an academy full of students and professors, but proving to the workers through experience and theory and to capitalists through force that it is inevitable and necessary.

Establishing historical-political-social facts according to conflicts in the productive substructure and not in an analysis that abstracts away from it and treats the facts as things for themselves. Emphasis on the importance of Marx's Introduction to *For the Critique of Political Economy*.

Instead of merely insinuating its possibility, or its conceptual possibility as an abstract social nature that is immobile and metaphysical, we approach it as a historical nature, as an outcome of a process, with the central attention on the proof with the available data, from which the only conclusion we can draw is that it is impossible for capitalism to survive beyond limits which are inherent to it, and that the necessity of communism is historically guaranteed. Central is the deduction from unfolding processes of the precise determinations of characters, relations, and institutions that the revolution will crush.

Only starting from this, is it possible to arrive at the determinations of communist production and distribution, only while following the anticipations of the real movement, on the thread of time.
